



SIENA FARMS' 2009 CSA Membership Program

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a collaboration between farmers and their customers to provide the year-round cash flow required to plant the fields each spring, and to create an intimate, season-long relationship between the farm and its customers. Your pre-season investment as a CSA member helps cover all of the upfront costs of the growing season (seeds, supplies, labor, etc.) before the harvest of fresh, home-grown produce begins in early summer.

Choose one or both of the following CSA membership programs:

Farmer's Choice BoxShare Membership; Pick up your "Share" of Siena Farms produce at Sofra Bakery in Cambridge (1 Belmont Street) every Thursday afternoon/evening. Your half-bushel box will contain a nice variety of the best of what our fields have to offer week-to-week throughout the 2009 harvest. The deliveries to Sofra will begin on Thursday, June 4 and continue for 25 weeks, finishing for the season on Thursday, November 19, the week before Thanksgiving. Any week you are not around to pick up your veggies, you are welcome to send a friend in your place. A Farmer's Choice membership costs \$750 for the season (averaging \$30/week of produce).

~~**Chef's Choice Discount Membership;** You're the Chef, so you get to choose. This program differs from the traditional CSA model in that there are no quantity or selection guidelines placed on your weekly produce supply; you simply shop to your heart's content as often as you like at any of our market locations (see below), using a member's discount off our market prices. A Half Share Chef's Choice membership for \$250 earns you a 25% discount all season, or a Full Share Chef's Choice membership for \$500 earns you a 50% discount. Please note that this discount applies to all of our farm-grown produce (veggies, fruits, flowers) but not to products we buy in for resale at market such as wild mushrooms, local eggs, Sofra goodies, etc.~~
